**Rob:** That's a bit rude.

**Feifei:** Oh sorry, I was just thinking to myself about the word 'no'.

**Rob:** Fascinating!

Feifei: Yes, I'm trying to work out how to help one of our listeners who sent us a

question to answer.

**Rob:** Oh yes?

Feifei: It's from Libbin Peng who says: I always confuse the grammatical use

for words 'no, not & not to'. Could you please explain how to use them?

Could you also give me some simple examples please? Thanks.

**Rob**: Thanks Libbin. There's no question too big or too small that we can't

answer.

these words are not all the same?

Rob: No. Let's start with that word, 'no'. Firstly, if you respond to a question

negatively then that's when you can say no. For example:

## **Example**

Can I have a pay rise?

No!

**Rob:** Yes! No can also be used as a determiner to express quantity. It's used in

front of singular and plural nouns to mean 'not any', but we say 'no' to

give it more negative effect. So instead of:

### **Example**

He must lead a lonely life: he doesn't have a wife and he doesn't have any children.

**Rob:** We say...

#### **Example**

He must lead a lonely life in that village: he has no wife and no children.

**Rob:** Also with countable nouns, 'no' is normally followed by plural forms, like

this:

## **Examples**

No students got an A grade in their exams this year.

No trains are running today because of the snow.

Feifei: No 后面可以连接名词单数或复数,其中可数名词多取复数形式。And Rob, we see

the word 'no' used in lots of signs?

**Rob**: Yes, like 'no smoking', 'no entry' and 'no eating in the studio' – Feifei could

you put that sandwich away please?

**Feifei:** No! Well, not unless we talk about the word 'not'.

Rob: OK, well 'not' is used to make a clause or sentence negative. Used before

a verb, it makes it negative, a bit like this:

## **Example**

Can we go home please? I'm really not enjoying this film.

**Rob:** It can also be used before an adjective:

## **Example**

not beautiful

**Rob:** Or a noun phrase.

#### **Examples:**

not the best

not my fault

**Example**

Feifei: Not 否定后面的介词短语。

**Rob:** Or even an adverb.

**Example** 

not quickly

Feifei: Not 还可以用来否定后面的副词。上面所举的所有例子都是用 not 来否定一个句子或

从句。It's not a very positive word is it?

**Rob:** It's not. And remember the word not often gets contracted into the

previous auxiliary verb. For example, 'could not' becomes 'couldn't', and

'cannot' becomes 'can't'.

Example

When I phoned my friend I couldn't get a reply.

couldn't. Finally Rob, we've got to talk about 'not to' 不要。

**Rob:** This is often used in a negative instruction or command and is another way

of saying you must not do something. For example:

**Examples** 

You are not to walk on the motorway at any time.

We were told not to eat the pork because it hadn't been cooked.

## **Example**

**Rob:** And what should other people do if there's something about the English

language they do not understand? Give up?
